- 6. The Army's Advance (28-34)

III. Consider the Implications of Isaiah 10:5-34

- 1. **Government**. Human governments are tools in God's hands for the accomplishment of His purposes.
- 2. **Pride**. God opposes the proud.
- 3. **Idolatry**. God is jealous for the affections and loyalty of His people, for their good!
- 4. **Trust**. To whom will you look for help in time of need?
- 5. **Fear**. There are no such things as chance or fate; Fear God.
- 6. **Trials**. God employs trials in your life to accomplish His good purposes.
- 7. Sin. God holds sinners accountable.
- 8. **Judgment**. God keeps His promises He follows through on judgment.
- 9. **Grace**. God is gracious to His people who do not deserve His grace.
